

During the COVID-19 crisis, the Board of Education's meetings will follow the guidance and requirements of the various phases of the State of Illinois' reopening plan. Board meetings will be held remotely, but will offer an in-person attendance option subject to social distancing and capacity requirements. For example, during Phase 4, attendance will be limited to 50 individuals and all must maintain social distancing of at least 6-feet and **MUST WEAR MASKS** while present within the meeting.

To Access the Board Meeting Remotely/Electronically

1. Access the Board of Education's meeting agenda by visiting the [School District's website](#). The agenda is posted at least 48-hours before the meeting begins.
2. On page one of the Agenda, locate the information for remote access via telephone. To access the meeting, dial the "Phone Number" and then enter the "Conference ID" provided on the agenda. You may be momentarily placed in a virtual waiting room until the meeting
3. Once the meeting is ready to begin, you will be granted access to the meeting and will be able to hear all meeting participants. Members of the public are not able to interact via the teleconference and the Board will not be able to hear those members of the public who are listening on the phone line.

To Participate in the "Comments or Questions from the Audience" portion of the meeting during Remote Attendance
